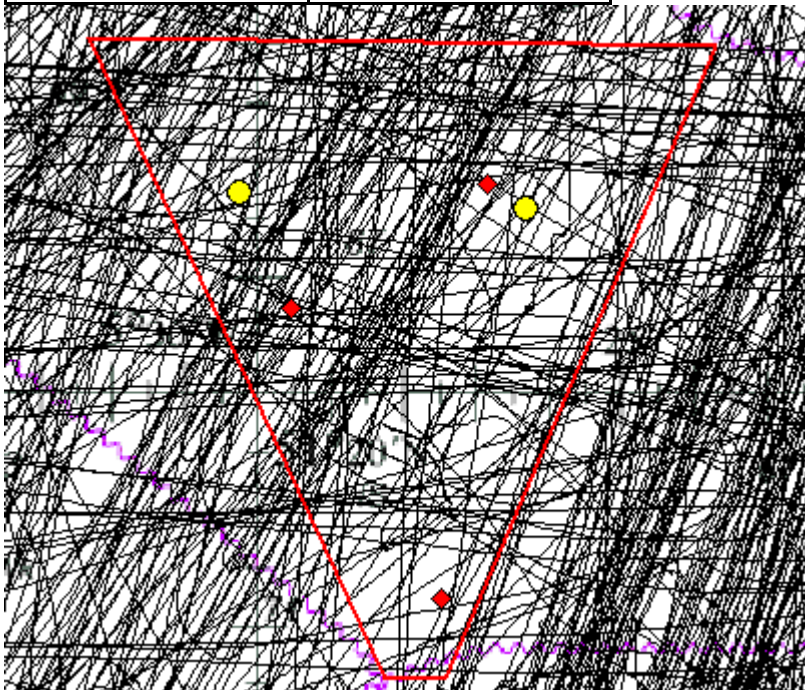

Our preferred choice would be your suggested southerly position but we have suggested a couple of alternatives shown in yellow dots.
