MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009: PART 4 – MARINE LICENSING

LICENCE FOR PENTHYNDEUDRAETH WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS – FINAL EFFLUENT OUTFALL PIPE REPAIRS.

Please find attached for your review and retention a copy of Marine Licence **CML2321v1** and its conditions.

This has been issued by the Marine Licensing Team within Natural Resources Wales, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, as Licensing Authority, under Part 4 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, for you to undertake the above stated works.

Please note that Marine Licence **CML2321v1** supersedes Marine Licence **CML2321** in its entirety.

The Marine licence has been varied to include the standard conditions associated with the deposition of concrete for the concrete headwall, which were not included within CML2321.

Change details

Addition of Condition 3.20 Use of Render and Concrete

The condition added here is a standard condition for concrete and render works, which were incorrectly omitted from the first issue of the Licence.

Advisory Note

Marine Licence, **CML2321v1**, constitutes a statutory consent; therefore the conditions set out herein must be complied with in full and will be binding upon any agent or contractor who undertakes any activity on the project on your behalf.

The Crown Estate is affected by the proposed works and landowner's consent is required. The applicant is requested to liaise with our Managing Agent for the area. Contact details were provided to the applicant over email on **24 May 2024**.

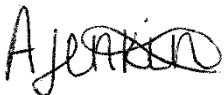

If the works authorised by this Licence are unlikely to be completed by the expiry date, the Licence Holder should apply for a replacement marine licence **at least 4 months** prior to the expiry date of this Licence.

Should you require clarification as to the reasons for the inclusion of any of the conditions attached to the Licence then you must request written notice within 28 days of the receipt of this letter.
