This has been issued by the Marine Licensing Team within Natural Resources Wales, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, as Licensing Authority, under Part 4 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, for you to undertake the above stated works.

Please note that Marine Licence **DML2302v1** supersedes Marine Licence DML2302 in its entirety.

The Marine licence has been varied to include the standard conditions associated with the disposal of dredged material, which were not included within DML2302.

Renumbering and rearranging of Activity Specific Conditions

Change made to improve clarity with respect to conditions relating to the same topic.

Correction to text of Condition 3.23 (Reporting of Artefacts)

Change made to clarify instruction set by this condition, this does not affect any actions required by this section.

Addition of Condition 3.18.4 and Condition set 3.19

The conditions added here form part of the set of standard conditions for dredge disposal activities, which were incorrectly omitted from the first issue of the Licence. The submitted data, as required by these conditions, allow Cefas to compile UK disposal records to OSPAR Commission to comply with the requirements of the OSPAR convention.

Advisory Note

Marine Licence, **DML2302v1**, constitutes a statutory consent; therefore the conditions set out herein must be complied with in full and will be binding upon any agent or contractor who undertakes any activity on the project on your behalf.

Marine Licence, **DML2302v1** is solely granted for the work to be undertaken with the area specified in the Licence; however, it does not absolve you from applying for further consents or licences as necessary to enable the full completion of your project.

If the works authorised by this Licence are unlikely to be completed by the expiry date, the Licence Holder should apply for a replacement marine licence **at least 4 months** prior to the expiry date of this Licence.
