Not sure if your getting confused as we have two email chains going on about different activities.

For masonry repair work as specified below – if it is in the existing boundary and consists or minor repair/maintenance works and not improvements or outside the existing boundary we would classify that as a band 1 marine licence (Email from Wednesday 5 July).

Please note if the works are not minor, outside of the existing boundary, improvement works or works to a coastal protection structure then it would not be considered a band 1 licence.

- *Minor maintenance including repairing, replacing or reasonably improving within the original design envelope, bolts, flaps, valves, cathodic protection, access covers, grills, joints, decking on a pier or pontoon, health and safety equipment or other ancillary equipment attached to existing structures. Note - This does not include fundamental alterations to the use of a structure. Repairs must be within the existing boundaries of the structure or assets being maintained.*

We would consider installation of grout bags and masonry repair works to come under construct, alter and improvement of a structure and therefore would need a marine licence. The non-licensable deposits by hand would be for activities such as deposition of sand bags.

Phase 1 - Our current plan of action would be to carry out temporary mitigation repairs by hand, as per the attached scoping document, to install grout bags & carry out various masonry repairs by hand.

Phase 2 – We would then look to construct a more considerable concrete toe, to prevent further scour damage to the structure. We would seek a Marine License for this.

Are you able to review & let us know if you are happy with this approach? As well as whether you believe that the works suggest for phase 1, are non-licensable.
