Description of activity	Limits of specified activity
The discharge shall consist only of waste sheep dip, derived from use at multiple locations used in accordance with the appropriate marketing authorisation issued by the Veterinary Medicines Directorate of the Department of the Environment, Food And Rural Affairs (DEFRA).	Waste sheep dip may only be discharged once on any individual area of land in any one year. Records should be kept of exactly where each disposal takes place within the overall disposal site.
