Emission monitoring agreement

Permit reference: AB3092CV/V007 (PAN-018868)

Operator: Enfinium Parc Adfer Operations Limited

Facility: Parc Adfer Energy Recovery Facility, Deeside Industrial Park, Deeside, Flintshire, CH5 2LL

In accordance with permit condition 3.6.1 and Schedule 3 Table S3.1 we confirm the following ongoing monitoring requirements upon issue of permit variation AB3092CV/V007, which will remain in force until such time as we confirm otherwise in writing:

For monitoring specified in Schedule 3– Emissions and monitoring, Table S3.1:

- Mercury and its compounds – continuous monitoring is not required
- Dioxins / furans (I-TEQ) – monthly long-term sampling monitoring is not not required

As per footnote 1 in Schedule 3 Table S3.1 continuous monitoring of mercury and its compounds does not apply for plants incinerating wastes with a proven low and stable mercury content. We will review the monitoring requirement for continuous monitoring of mercury and its compounds following continued submission of such proof, either via ongoing emissions monitoring required by the permit, or otherwise. Improvement Condition IC9 has been completed.

As per footnote 2 in Schedule 3 Table S3.1 long term sampling of dioxins and furans does not apply if the emission levels are proven to be sufficiently stable. We will review the monitoring requirement for long term sampling of dioxins and furans following submission of such proof, either via ongoing emissions monitoring required by the permit or otherwise.
