Good afternoon Neville,

Thanks for taking the time to speak to me earlier and providing me with the coordinates of the slipway.

Having viewed the location on GIS, I can confirm that it is not located within a protected site. The closest sites are the Fishguard Cliffs SSSI and the West Wales Marine SAC, both of which are 300m away.

During our conversation you confirmed the following:

- The area of the slipway that is being replaced is within the same footprint as the original structure. The works are simply to replace what has been lost through erosion.
- 2 cubic metres of silt will be removed to allow access to the bottom section of the slipway. This silt will be deposited next to the toe of the slipway and allowed to redistribute naturally with the tide.
- The shuttering to be installed will either be made from plywood or steel, potentially with some timber supports, and will be installed by hand.

Given the above, we recommend that you submit a Band 1 application, we will then confirm at duly making that we are satisfied with the complete method statement and that the works are minor in nature. Contractor is one of our Framework Contractors and will be issued with NRW pollution prevention guidelines.

Good afternoon Neville,

Although the slipway forms part of the sea wall structure, it is not sea wall or coastal defence structure itself and therefore, the exemption wouldn't apply.

As such, a marine licence would be required to undertake the repairs however, what band of licence you will need depends on the scale, methods and location of the works. I advise that you take a look at the link provided and come back to us with some more detail on your methods, scale, timing of the works, cost of the works etc. and we'll then be able to advise you further.

Pembrokeshire County Council wish to undertake a minor repair to an existing slipway at Lower Town Fishguard.

The slip is located just below mean high water and forms part of the sea wall structure.

We need to reconstruct approx. 1-1.5m of the bottom section which has been eroded away by the river and tide.

On your website it states - A licence is also not required for an activity carried out by or on behalf of the coast protection authority (usually the local authority) for the purpose of maintaining coastal protection works.

Could you confirm what licence is required if any for us to carry out these works.
