NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF CONSENT TO DISCHARGE

Following a review of the conditions of its consent, the **ENVIRONMENT AGENCY** ("The Agency") in pursuance of its powers under the Water Resources Act 1991 **HEREBY MODIFIES ITS CONSENT** to the making of a discharge **OF SEWAGE EFFLUENT**, as follows:

Secondary Treated Sewage Effluent incorporating the requirements of the Urban Waste Water Treatment Regulations (UWWTR) 1994

with respect to Modification Notice of Consent No CG0088601 served on the 19th day of March 2009

FROM: Betws Yn Rhos Wastewater Treatment Works

AT: Betws Yn Rhos, Abergele, Conwy LL22 8AW

TO: An un-named tributary of the Afon Dulas

FROM NOW ON the consent is modified as follows:

Substitution of Condition 13 in Schedule CG0088601 01 by the following new condition:


COMPOSITION

13. (a) Subject to paragraph (b) below, the Discharge shall not contain more than:
- (i) 20 milligrammes per litre of biochemical oxygen demand (measured after 5 days at 20°C with nitrification suppressed by the addition of allyl-thiourea);
 - (ii) 30 milligrammes per litre of suspended solids (measured after drying at 105°C).
- (b) The limit for any of the relevant parameters set out in paragraph (a) above may be exceeded where, in any series of samples of the Discharge taken at regular but randomised intervals in any period of twelve consecutive months as listed in Column 1 of the table at Annex 1 to this consent, no more than the relevant number of samples, as listed in Column 2 of the said table, exceed the applicable limit for that relevant parameter.

NOTE. All other conditions of this consent remain unaltered and in force. This modification of consent should be read in conjunction with, and attached to Consent No CG0088601.

Under the provisions of Paragraphs 7 and 8 of Schedule 10 to the Water Resources Act 1991, no notice shall be served by the Agency, which alters the effect of modifications made by this notice, without the agreement in writing of the Consent Holder, during a period of 4 years from the date this notice is served.

This modification is served and takes effect on the 9th day of June 2009
