We need more information about your application

Application reference: PAN-022943

Thank you for your application received on 11/08/2023. Unfortunately, we need to ask you for some more details before we can consider duly making your application. The additional information required is summarised below.

- **Risk Assessments**

Air Quality Model Input Files

Please provide the model input files to support the air dispersion modelling report submitted with the application.

- **Operating Techniques & BAT Assessment**

We need more information about the processes which give rise to the two additional point source emissions to be added to the permit. Please confirm if these processes are new or if existing, provide evidence that they have already undergone an assessment against BAT and are already referenced within your operating techniques as listed within Table S1.2 of your permit. Where a BAT assessment and operational techniques relevant to these processes already exist, please submit copies of these with your application.

If the processes as well as the emission points have not previously been assessed as part of your original application or subsequent permit variations, please submit technical details of the processes to be included in the permit, as well as a technical assessment demonstrating that the processes which give rise to the two additional point source emissions meet Best Available Techniques (BAT).

Within your application you have referenced a number of documents contained within your existing Environmental Management System (EMS) which detail existing procedures and

monitoring plans which will ensure that emissions and other environmental or operational risks are appropriately managed from the two new point source emissions. Please provide copies of the existing management systems / plans as referenced within section 2.3 of your application.

- **Site Plans & Drawings**

Site Emissions Point Layout Plan

We require an updated site Emissions Point Plan which clearly identifies the location of all existing and new emission points to be added to the permit - along with their proposed numbering (i.e. A1 - A7). At present the emissions point plan references A5 (Grinder Emission) as a points source emission to atmosphere, however this contradicts statements made within your application which states that A5 does not emit to atmosphere but discharges within the building, and therefore does not need to be referenced on the plan as a point source emission to atmosphere.

Process Flow Diagram

Please provide a Process Flow Diagram (PFD) which illustrates how the proposed changes and additional point source emissions interface with existing plant configuration. If available submit P&ID drawings relevant to the point source emissions to be added to the permit.

- **Form F1 Q5 – Confidentiality**

We note that you have not ticked the box on page 3 Section 5 of F1 Form stating you wish to claim confidentiality for your application. However at the same time, your supporting document (referenced 330202179TN1) states that the document is confidential. Please clarify if you wish to claim confidentiality. If your answer is yes, you will need to submit a standalone letter giving your reasons for your request.

- **Form F1 Q7d – Declaration**

The declaration on page 5 Section 7d of F1 Form has not been signed by a relevant person. 'Relevant Person' means (in the case of a company) a director, manager, company secretary or any similar officer or employee listed on current appointments in Companies House.
