

REQUEST TO EXTEND MARINE LICENCE

Bombora Wavepower Europe Ltd. would like to request an extension to the Marine Licence (ORML 1924) for the installation, operation, maintenance and decommissioning of a full-scale wave energy device.

The Marine Licence (ORML 1924) was granted on 23 October 2019 for a period of 4 years. At that point, we had envisaged that we would install the mWave device in summer 2020 and operate for 6 months to one year, then allow 6 months for decommissioning. Unfortunately, due to funding related constraints the assembly of the mWave was heavily disrupted on put on hold for 5 months. Assembly has however restarted, and we anticipate completion of testing and assembly of the device in February 2024 and deployment in March 2024. No works under the marine licence have been undertaken to date. Some works under the Planning Consent have been undertaken. We will also be applying for an extension to the Planning Consent from PCNPA.

We request a one-year extension to the consent to be able to complete the project. This gives us sufficient time for at least 6 months operation as well as decommissioning. The requested revised expiry date is 22 October 2024.

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
