Condition 1, Conditions of consent for biologically treated sewage disinfected by ultra violet (UV), has been amended as follows:

1 Conditions of consent for secondary treated sewage effluent

Condition 1.1, Nature, has been amended as follows:

The Discharge shall consist solely of secondary treated sewage effluent.

Condition 1.10, Recording and Reporting, have been amended as follows:

1.10 Recording and Reporting

- a The Operator shall establish and operate a documented maintenance programme and record all non-routine actions undertaken that may have adversely affected effluent quality. Copies of the programme shall be made available for inspection by the Environment Agency's officers at all reasonable times.
- b On request the Operator shall supply the Environment Agency with a written report on the maintenance and all non-routine actions that may have adversely affected effluent quality.
