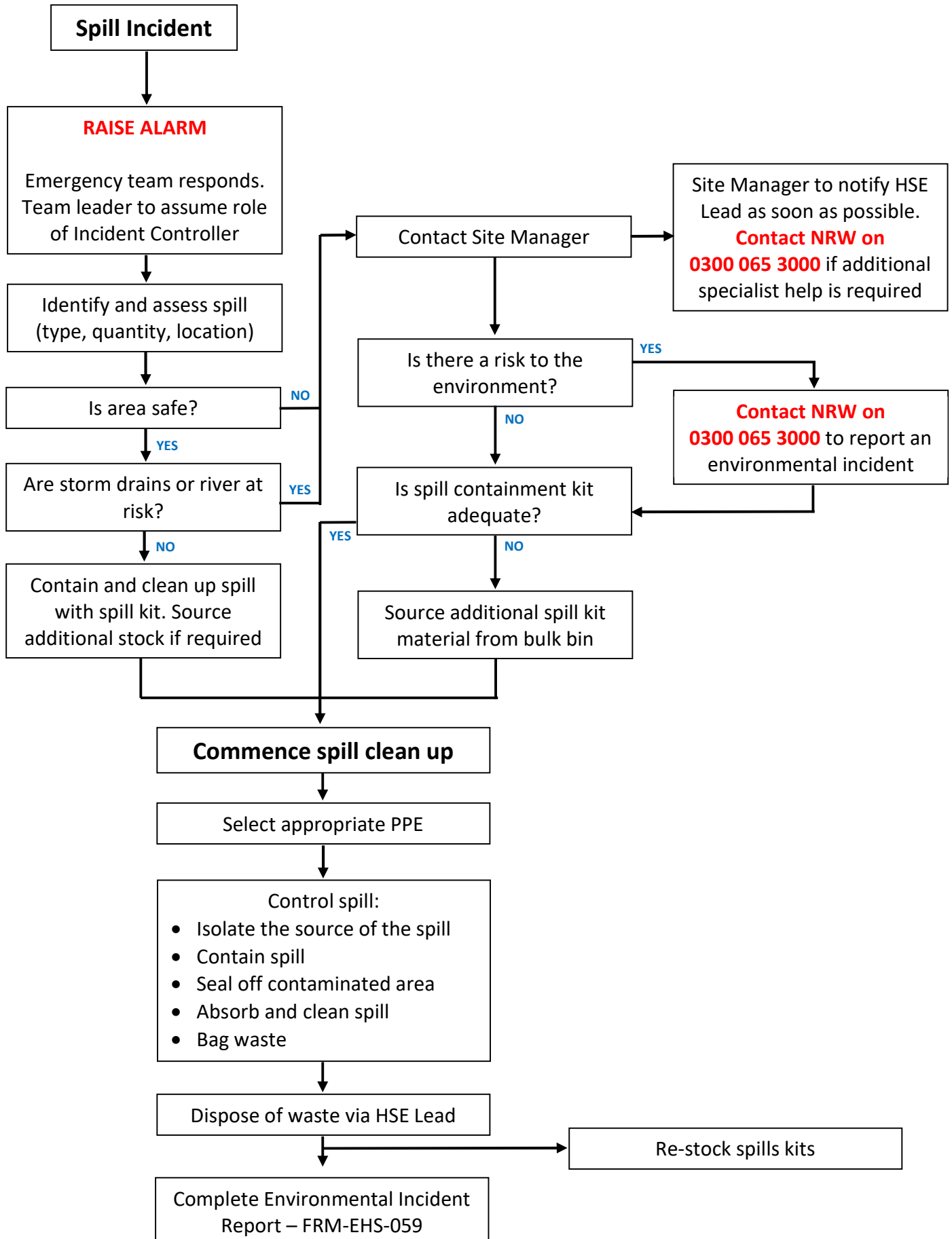




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EP-021 Dairy Partners Spill Response Plan



Spill response flow charts are displayed at the following locations:

1. Reception
2. Dairy process areas
3. Warehouse
4. Milk Intake Office
5. Effluent Treatment Plant
6. Boiler House / Oil storage area
7. Chemical compound
8. Laboratory

Spill kits are located around the site in strategic areas at risk from milk, whey/cream, oil or effluent spillages.

Spill kits are inspected on a regularly basis to ensure they always contain at least the contents detailed on the inventory and to ensure they are maintained in a dry, usable condition.

When spill kit contents are used, it is the responsibility of the person using the contents to ensure either Engineering Dept and /or HSE Lead is notified to coordinate a refill of the bin.

Staff using the contents to contain a spill must also have received spill response training and ensure they are using the correct materials for the spill material. They are also responsible for ensuring contaminated spill kit materials are currently bagged. Once bagged, inform the site HSE Lead for advice on disposal.

Environmental Incident Report – FRM-EHS-059 is to be completed and passed to the HSE Lead for review and any follow-up action identified.

Spill Kits are available in the following locations and each has its own contents Inventory:

KIT 1 – Large bulk bin outside of Boiler House

KIT 2 – Inside Boiler House

KIT 3 – Inside Chemical R.O.

KIT 4 – River Kit at WWTP

KIT 5 – WWTP – next to DAF 2 / Polymer Tanks

KIT 6 – Outside of Old CIP / cream fill area

KIT 1:

- 25 x chemical pads
- 5 x 1.5m universal-use spill socks
- 2 x hazardous waste bags and ties
- 5 x spill pillows
- 2 x emergency clay drain covers
- 1 x hazard warning tape
- Gloves

KIT 2:

- 5 x 1.5m oil spill socks
- 2 x hazardous waste bags and ties
- 5 x spill pillows
- 1 x emergency clay drain cover
- 1 x tub of Dammit
- Gloves

KIT 3:

- 5 x 1.5m universal-use spill socks
- 2 x hazardous waste bags and ties
- 5 x spill pillows
- 20 x chemical pads
- Gloves

KIT 4:

- 6 x oil river booms
- 2 x hazardous waste bags and ties
- Gloves

KIT 5:

- 5 x 1.5m universal-use spill socks
- 5 x chemical absorbent pillows
- 25 x chemical pads
- 2 x hazardous waste bags and ties
- Gloves

KIT 6:

- 10 x 1.5m universal-use socks
- 5 x chemical absorbent pillows
- 25 x chemical pads
- 2 x hazardous waste bags and ties
- Gloves

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
