Further to your application the Agency has decided that consent should be given subject to conditions. I enclose the Agency's formal consent to discharge sewage effluent (in an emergency) from foul pumping station at St. Asaph Business Park, St. Asaph.

Under the present Scheme of Charges for Discharges to Controlled Waters an annual charge will be made for all consents to discharge, except where the discharge is of sewage effluent of five cubic metres or less per day. The charge is based on information derived from the conditions attached to the consent to discharge, as outlined in the enclosed leaflet.

If you consider that the conditions imposed by the consent are unreasonable you have a right of appeal to National Assembly for Wales at Cathays Park, Cardiff CF10 3NQ.

Notice of an appeal must be given in writing within three months of this notification and must be accompanied by a statement of the grounds of appeal.

If granted, a consent under Schedule 10 of the Act, covers water quality considerations only. It does not alter the need to obtain any other consents or approvals which might be required in connection with your proposal under other legislation. For example it does not give any right or permission to discharge where land is not owned by the applicant.

Please take careful note that if the holder of the consent changes, you must inform the Agency IN WRITING as soon as possible of the name of the new holder. This is to ensure that the rights and charges associated with the Consent are transferred to the new holder. A Certificate of Holder notice will be sent to you shortly which is designed for this purpose, and should be kept safely with the Consent until required.



CONDITIONS OF CONSENT TO DISCHARGE

Sewage in an Emergency ("the Discharge")

FROM: Foul Pumping Station, St Asaph Business Park, St Asaph

NATURE

1. The Discharge shall consist solely of sewage in an emergency.
2. The Discharge shall only occur when the sewage pumping station is inoperative as a result of one or more of the following:
 - (i) electrical power failure not due to the act or default of the consent holder, its agents, representatives, officers, employees or servants;
 - (ii) mechanical breakdown of duty and standby pumps;
 - (iii) rising main failure;
 - (iv) blockage of the downstream sewer not due to the act or default of the consent holder, its agents, representatives, officers, employees or servants;

and it is not reasonably practicable to dispose of the sewage otherwise. There shall be no undue delay on the part of the consent holder in remedying any such failure or breakdown.

LOCATION

3. The Discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as:
 - (a) discharging via a 450 millimetre diameter pipe
 - (b) discharging via a surface water sewer to the Pengwern Ditch;
 - (c) at National Grid Reference SJ 0186 7469;
 - (d) shown marked 'Discharge Point' on Plan CG0392601 attached as Annex 1.

SAMPLING POINTS

4. The outlet to the watercourse shall be constructed and maintained so that a representative sample of the Discharge may be obtained at National Grid Reference SJ 0186 7469 as shown marked 'Discharge Point' on Plan CG0392601.

VOLUME

5. Storage capacity, equivalent to a total of at least 24 hours of the dry weather flow in the sewer immediately upstream of the pumping station, shall be provided in the pumping station and/or the upstream sewerage system, above the wet well design top water level.

For the purpose of this condition Dry Weather Flow shall mean the average daily flow as measured in the sewer immediately upstream of the pumping station during seven consecutive days without rain (excluding a period which includes public holidays) following seven days during which the rainfall did not exceed 0.25 millimetres on any one day.

COMPOSITION

6.
 - (a) The Discharge shall have passed, without prior comminution or maceration, through a screening device having apertures no greater than 10 millimetres in two dimensions.
 - (b) The screening device shall be maintained in an efficient operational condition.
 - (c) All screenings must be removed and disposed of in a manner such as to prevent entry to the discharge.

RECORDING AND REPORTING

7.
 - (a) The consent holder shall establish and operate a documented maintenance programme and record all non-routine actions undertaken that may have adversely affected the operation of the pumping station. Copies of the programme shall be made available for inspection by the Agency's officers at all reasonable times.
 - (b) On request the consent holder shall supply the Agency with a written report on the maintenance and all non-routine actions that may have adversely affected the operation of the pumping station.

OTHER

8. (a) A 24 hour response telemetry alarm system shall be provided and maintained to give notification of failure or breakdown of the pumping station.
(b) The consent holder shall take all reasonable remedial measures to return the pumping station to normal operation, as soon as practicable after warning of failure or breakdown of the pumping station.
9. On request the consent holder shall supply the Agency with a written report on the operation of the emergency overflow.
10. Facilities shall be provided so that a mobile stand-by generator may readily be installed at the pumping station in the event of electrical failure and the Consent Holder shall install and operate such a generator as soon as is practicable after an electrical failure.
12. The duty pump shall be maintained in good working order, and at least one stand-by pump shall be provided and maintained.
13. Stand-by pumps shall activate as soon as practicable should the duty pumps become inoperative for reasons other than power failure. The pumping station shall be maintained so that the pump shall reactivate as soon as is practicable after the power is restored after interruption to the supply.
14. A tanker access facility at an appropriate location shall be provided and maintained to enable removal of sewage by tanker when necessary.





I am writing regarding your application for the above consent, and the ongoing determination process. Having undertaken further consultation, a number of issues have arisen that we require clarification on:


1. On the drainage plan (No. CF1072/020/001/C90)L001) the legend shows the blue line as the foul water drain and the brown line as the surface water drain. Can you confirm if this is the case, as at present the only pumping station marked on the plan appears to be on the surface water drain system.
2. There is no indication on the drawing as to the point where the pumping station connects to the surface water drain. Should a sample require to be taken, the discharge would be sampled just before it enters the surface water drain. Consequently can you please provide a location plan showing the proposed sample point, along with an 8 figure grid reference. Normally this point would be at a suitable manhole, for ease of access.
3. For the purposes of the consenting procedure the point at which the emergency overflow enters the surface water drain is the discharge point. Can you please provide the 8 figure grid reference for this point, and also confirm that the WDA own the surface water drain. I apologise for any confusion over the location of the discharge point.
4. Finally, can you please provide details of the storage capacity and retention time in the wet well, before the emergency overflow would become operational.




