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5. In the event of an emergency, a minimum of 6 hours storage capacity shall be available before discharge commences, based on the design dry weather sewage flow.
6. Standby equipment shall be provided to enable the immediate resumption of full pumping capacity in the event of a duty equipment failure.
7. The Pumping Station shall have the capability of automatic restart on restoration of the power supply following power supply failure.
8. A plug-in facility shall be provided for emergency power supply to the station in the event of power supply failure.
9. The Pumping Station shall be equipped with an automatic remote alarm system to alert the discharger immediately of any significant station failure.
10. The Authority shall be notified of any discharge as soon as reasonably practicable and in any case within 24 hours.
11. All reasonable practical steps shall be taken to minimise the duration of the discharge and its polluting effects.
12. The discharger shall pay all reasonable costs to the Authority in relation to any anti-pollution works or operations carried out in respect of poisonous, noxious or polluting matter or solid waste present in controlled waters as a result of a discharge.

CONDITIONS OF CONSENT

1. The discharge shall consist only of sewage discharged in an emergency to avoid danger to life or health, an electrical or mechanical breakdown of such severity as to render the pumping station completely inoperable, total failure of the external power supply or total blockage of the rising main shall be considered an emergency. An emergency shall not include station shut-down to facilitate maintenance or refurbishment.
2. The discharge shall only take place when it is not reasonably practical to dispose of the sewage by other means.
3. The discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as follows:-

Discharge via : A pipe of 9 inch diameter.

Discharge to : The Pengwern Drain.

At OS Grid Ref. : SJ 0218.7414

As shown marked : "Discharge Point" on the attached plan number CM0067702

4. Equipment shall be provided to remove all unacceptable solid matter from the effluent prior to discharge, as approved in writing by the Authority.

### Consent

to bringing into use a new or altered outlet and/or making a new discharge of trade or sewage effluent to a stream or to tidal waters which are controlled waters.

The Dee and Clwyd River Authority, pursuant to Section 7 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act, 1951, HEREBY GRANT CONSENT to the discharge of sewage from an emergency overflow at the Council's sewage pumping station at Bettir Lane, St. Asaph, into an unnamed tributary of Pont Robin Out,

being a stream/~~controlled waters~~ in the Dee and Clwyd River Authority Area in accordance with your application dated the 21st October, 1971,

SUBJECT to the following conditions:—

1. The discharge shall be confined to periods of electrical power failure.
2. The Council shall, as soon as practicable, inform the River Authority whenever a discharge has taken place.

The terms of this Consent will not, without the consent in writing of the person to whom this Consent is given (or his successor), be altered before the expiration of the period ending with the 31st day of March, 1974.
