MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009: PART 4 – MARINE LICENSING

LICENCE FOR Câr-y-Môr Seaweed and Shellfish IMTA Site in Ramsey Sound

I am writing to advise you that the Marine Licensing Team, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, as Licensing Authority, have varied your Marine Licence based upon the outcome of the Appeal (CAS-02246-C1H3Q3), and hereby issue a Marine Licence for you to undertake the above stated works.

Accordingly, please find attached for your review and retention a copy of Marine Licence **DEML2151v1** and its conditions.

The Marine Licence has been varied as follows;

- extending the expiry date of the licence from 22 March 2027 to 22 March 2042
- the addition of condition 3.17 requiring production and adherence to a Monitoring Programme
- amendment to condition 3.18.1 relating to decommissioning to reflect the extended duration of the licence.

Advisory Note

Marine Licence, **DEML2151v1**, constitutes a statutory consent; therefore the conditions set out herein must be complied with in full and will be binding upon any agent or contractor who undertakes any activity on the project on your behalf.

You are urged to read the conditions of Marine Licence **DEML2151v1** carefully. Marine Licence, **DEML2151v1** is solely granted for the work to be undertaken at **Câr-y-Môr IMTA site in Ramsey Sound**; however, it does not absolve you from applying for further consents or licences as necessary to enable the full completion of your project. This may include an EPS licence requirement for seahorses should they be encountered within the Project site and you should engage with NRW Advisory if they are recorded.

If the works authorised by this Licence are unlikely to be completed by the expiry date, the Licence Holder should apply for a replacement marine licence **at least 4 months** prior to the expiry date of this Licence.

Should you require clarification as to the reasons for the inclusion of any of the conditions attached to the Licence then you must request written notice within 28 days of the receipt of this letter.

Please be advised post-consent work associated with this Marine Licence will be charged in line with the [Marine Licensing fees](#) which are detailed on our website. Submission of monitoring specification or annual monitoring reports for approval are charged at an hourly rate of £120 per hour. Monitoring submission should be made via our [online form](#).
