Hi Nicholas, Thanks for checking. The induction needs to be done before any Works are carried out and certainly if you are on site, doing any works, without anyone from ABP escorting you.

I appreciate it is difficult but the closer the induction is done to the actual Works the better for freshness of the requirements. the induction on line is generic but covers a range of aspects and it is worth doing all of them expect for the office one. This one is not relevant in this instance.

It would pay to do the induction before you attend site but certainly within a month of doing the activity.

Once a start date is agreed/determined, as the online induction is completed, on the day of the Works commencing, we will do a site specific induction and issue a site pass.

You are then OK to proceed without being escorted.

As you know I recently went to site with a GI Contractor from Tetra Tech to look at the proposed spec by our Consultants Arup

Attached is a drawing illustrating the location of various sampling, I'd just like to draw you attention to

BH02- Bore Hole 2. The location originally proposed by Arup is not feasible and the contractor proposes two alternative locations indicated on the attached document- both of which are adjacent to the access road

Could you advise on the size of vehicle using this road- the rig would allow space for cars to pass but anything larger would not be able to pass while the rig is operating during the potential 3-4 days of work.

Secondly the contractor proposed the compound area could be located in the area in front of the bridge- we will do a land reg search but just wanted to check if this is ABP land to your knowledge?
