Thank you for your application received on 01/09/2022.

I need to ask you for some more information before I can do any more work on it. Please would you

- provide us with more information to question 3d, Form C2. We need to know more details on any changes or additions to your environmental management system as a result of increase in production.
- provide us with more information to question 6 Form C2. Can you confirm if the total daily volume and instantaneous flow for water discharge will remain unchanged as a result of the increase in capacity. Can you also confirm if the effluent treatment plant will also be able to meet both the current limits and the BAT emission limits after the 04/12/2023.
- provide us with more information on containment. As you are adding new storage silos and vats we need to know what additional secondary and tertiary containment the site will have as a result of the additional storage of whey concentrate, milk and cream silos and the 2 x 30000 liters chesses vats.
- provide us with more information on question 3b on Form C3. Can you provide an odour risk assessment for the site as a result increase in protection capacity and storage.
