The Dee and Clwyd River Authority, pursuant to Section 7 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act, 1951, HEREBY GRANT CONSENT to the discharge of purified domestic sewage effluent from the Council's sewage disposal works at Bronyoch into the Afon Tryweryn

being a stream/~~controlled waters~~ in the Dee and Clwyd River Authority Area in accordance with your application dated the 26th October, 1973,

SUBJECT to the following conditions:—

1. The effluent discharged shall:—

- (a) have a pH of not less than 5 and not more than 9;
- (b) have a Biochemical Oxygen Demand in 5 days at 20°C of not more than 20 milligrams per litre;
- (c) contain not more than 30 milligrams of suspended solids, dried at 105°C, per litre.

2. The volume of effluent discharged under dry weather conditions shall not exceed 36.9 cubic metres (8100 gallons) in any period of twenty-four hours.

The terms of this Consent will not, without the consent in writing of the person to whom this Consent is given (or his successor), be altered before the expiration of the period ending with the 31st day of December, 1975.
