OFF-SITE LANDSCAPE ENHANCEMENTS

1. Specimen tree planting along the edge of Chirk, to soften views of the edge of Chirk from Chirk Castle, and other locations within the AONB.
2. New native woodland belts to increase woodland cover, link existing woodland and enhance biodiversity.
3. New native planting south of the A5, to screen the wider Kronospan facility from the road.
4. Changes to hedgerow management along the Offa's Dyke Path National Trail and adjacent minor roads within the AONB
