Leachate levels have increased due to the external market pressures of caustic soda, which has led to a reduction in the volume of leachate being treated on site. Treatment capacity will continue be reviewed. No emission to the environment has occurred as a result. In total for the reporting period, 19,683m³ was removed from site via the Leachate Treatment Plant. We will continue to target leachate level reduction across the site.
