We need more information about your application

Application reference: PAN-023276
Operator: 3C Waste Limited
Facility: Llandulas Landfill Site

Thank you for your application received on 15/09/2023.

I need to ask you for some more information before I can do any more work on it. Please provide the following information:

1. Provide us with the quantity of waste to be considered under the recovery activity. We need to know the volume of inert waste you are applying for. Section 2.2 of the Waste Recovery Plan you have submitted indicates a volume of 222,202 m³ that is still required to be filled as of February 2023. You will need to re-submit a revised Waste Recovery Plan which states the minimum amount of inert waste which you are applying for, and justification on how this amount has been calculated. 2. State whether you are applying for a R5 or R10 activity, or both. The documents you have submitted do not make it clear whether you are applying for one or both activities. You will also need to state the tonnages or volumes of waste to be considered under this/these activity/activities, as well as any difference in materials or waste codes used. You will need to re-submit revised versions of any documents and forms which refer to the activity codes.
3. Section 2.2 of the Waste Recovery Plan states "The amount of material required to achieve the required restoration profile...". You need to clarify which restoration profile and which obligation this is referring to. We will need this information to determine whether this activity can be considered a recovery activity or not.
4. Figure 4 in section 1.4 of the Waste Recovery Plan refers to Drawing "ESID5". Any
