Hello Chloe,

I have been assigned to the case and I am currently working on your screening opinion request SC2305. Assuming the application is not considered screened into needing an EIA, we will consider this to be a band 2 project. With your application you will need to submit a complete and signed application form, a WFD compliance assessment, a method statement, an environmental report containing sufficient information for us to conduct a HRA (pathways, impacts, mitigation measures, etc), a Welsh National Marine Plan signposting document. You will know you have to show consideration of the Shoreline Management Plan for this project.

A CEMP will be helpful, and it might be worth touch base with the archaeological consultees (Welsh Archaeological Trust, CADW, RCAHMW) to ensure there will not be archaeological issues as a WSI might be required. Also, check with NRW A to make sure a Biosecurity Risk Assessment will not be needed (I do not think you will need one but best to check).

I think that should be all but other matters might arise during consultation as we will consult with navigation bodies, local planning, etc.

Good afternoon marine licencing team,

Submitted to you last Friday (NRW ref: WPCC13688, Our ref: SC2305) was an EIA screening document which is related to this email enquiry.

We wanted to make a formal pre-application enquiry about the list of documents that are essential/ nice to have's for our full marine licence application. Here is the list of documents we plan to submit with the marine licence application:

- Preliminary Ecological Appraisal (PEA)
- WFD stage 1 and 2
- HRA stage 1 and 2
- Project Environmental Report
- Environmental Action Plan (EAP, a Construction Environmental Management Plan equivalent)
- Method Statement

From the preapplication advice we have received so far, it indicates that statutory EIA will not be required and a band 2 marine licence will satisfy the needs of this project. We are currently preparing our application for the marine licence using the band 2 format, unless advised otherwise. Once this and all the documents in the list above are prepared, we will be submitting an application for a band 2 marine licence once we have received a response from the EIA screening opinion (NRW ref: WPCC13688, Our ref: SC2305).

In the hopes to remove the need for pre-commencement conditions, which would likely delay the project, I wanted to get in touch to make sure we have a complete first submission that will satisfy your needs. If there are documents you would like to see submitted with our band 2 marine licence, please can you inform us of these?
