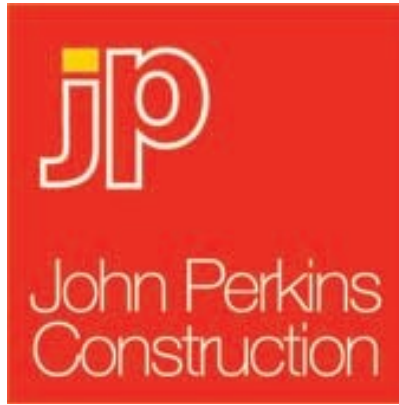




Newport Transporter Bridge

SITE RULES

- 1.0 All visitors and contractors must report to the site office. All Contractors must 'Sign In' in the Site Manager's Day Book. At the end of each shift and the contractor must sign out.
- 2.0 Site working hours strictly 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturday by prior agreement
- 3.0 JPC Covid procedures are to be strictly adhered to.
- 4.0 An acceptable standard of clothing, must be maintained at all times heavily torn clothing or the removal of tops etc will not be allowed and those found at odds with this will be asked to leave site.
- 5.0 All contractors must remain acutely aware of the environment within which they are working and therefore the standards of behaviour that are required, namely:
 - No foul language
 - No comments to Members of the Public except to prevent a possible H&S issue
 - To be courteous at all times when addressed but to refer all conversations to the Site Manager.
- 6.0 At a minimum the following PPE must be worn at all times, Safety Helmet, Safety Footwear, High Viz jacket or vest. Other PPE must be worn as required by the task in hand and as highlighted by the relevant trade specific Method Statement and Risk Assessment, issued prior to commencement of the works
- 7.0 All contractors will be required to attend a regular 'Tool Box Talk' on a subject relevant to the works in hand.
- 8.0 Evidence of all relevant certification for use of plant and equipment to be provided to the Site Manager prior to commencement of any works.

- 9.0 The following activities are prohibited on site:
- Smoking
 - Consumption of Alcohol or Drugs
 - Radios/Personal music devices
- 10.0 All visitors must sign in the Site Manager's Day Book and be escorted by Site Manager or other designated person.
- 11.0 No parking is permitted on Site. Tools as required can be dropped off at the site, and off site parking is via the Mill st car park.
