Carmarthenshire County Council are proposing to develop the Llanelli Wellness and Life Science Village (LWLV) south of Llanelli which would include a number of buildings, facilities and services to improve people's quality of life, improve health and/or provide research opportunities within the health arena.

As part of this, there is a requirement to provide an infill to the existing sluice gate stop logs on site, to satisfactorily attenuate discharge arising from extreme flood levels, taking into account climate change over a period of 100 years. The scope of the work includes the design and installation of a 3.5m high section of steel or concrete to sit on top of the existing steel sluice gate on the west side of the New Dafen River.
