



Operating Boundary

Bund or silt fence to be placed by Redstart prior to works to prevent run off into drainage ditch along southeast

Silt fence placed by site owner to prevent run off to the south and southwest of the site / stockpile.



Access to working area along private track and through Gates controlled by Banksman. Out of hours and weekend CCTV security cameras protecting the site entrance and equipment will be utilised.

Stockpile 'J' Material. The stockpiled material will be visually screened and manually picked through with all visible ACM > 40mm square removed, double bagged and placed in lockable Asbestos labelled skip for off-site disposal. Once removal is complete, the former base of the stockpile to be inspected and sampled ensuring all stockpiled materials have been removed and no residual ACM impact remains.

Location of Boundary Monitoring Points (6 x boundary Background and 1 x personal airborne Asbestos fibre monitoring).

No fugitive dust or excessive noise from the site operations are expected. Daily assessment of sound and dust will be made by the site management. Should excessive noise or dust be generated during the works monitoring will be undertaken.

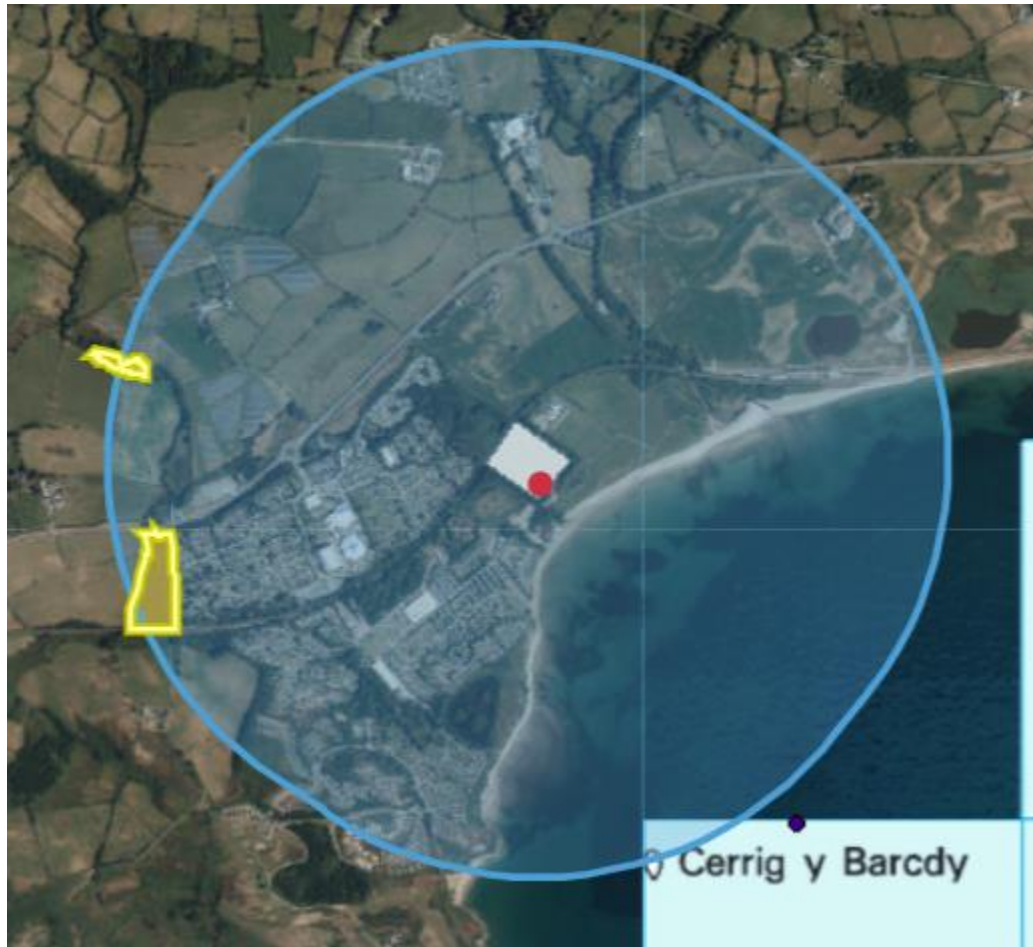
