Warning letter

Further to Natural Resources Wales's ongoing investigation into suspected illegal activity at Enviroventure Waste Solutions on **09 September 2023**. (Please refer to Compliance Assessment Report form CAR_NRW0042489 for full detail of permit breaches). After an extensive investigation, I now write to update you. NRW have completed their investigations into the matter and have identified the following offence:

Offence

It is an offence for a company to contravene Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016, Contrary to Regulation 38 (2).

The above offence relating to the contravention of permit conditions 1.1.1 and 2.1 at EPR/JB3531AB, Enviroventure Waste Solutions, SA73 1DP. On this occasion we are issuing you a warning letter as a response to the above offence. However, our decision could change if any further relevant information comes to light, including, but not restricted to, information that:

On this occasion we are issuing you a **warning letter** as a response to the above offence. However, our decision could change if any further relevant information comes to light, including, but not restricted to, information that:

- you have committed earlier offences
- the environmental impacts of these offences are greater than we presently understand them
- the offences are continuing or have been repeated
- you have committed other offences of which we are presently unaware.

We will take this into account if we consider that you are involved in any future offending.

This warning does not:

- prevent any other prosecuting authority taking action against you/the Company; or
- affect our right to issue enforcement, clear-up or remediation notices, or seek recovery of costs or damages according to law.

You should also be aware that under the Landfill Disposal Tax (Wales) Act 2017 (LDTA), certain disposals of waste, made at a place other than an authorised landfill site (unauthorised disposals) are subject to landfill disposal tax. This tax is collected and managed by the Welsh Revenue Authority (WRA). Under Section 60 of this Act, Natural Resources Wales may share information with WRA to assist in the collection and management of this tax, and therefore WRA may consider landfill disposal tax to be chargeable in this case.
