Brief description of licence variation that is required. (Identify licence condition numbers and reference the supporting documents within your current licence which are likely to be affected)
<p>AyM onshore Ground Investigation campaign is due to start this spring. Part of the onshore campaign includes 3 boreholes and 3 CPTs within the intertidal region of the AyM export cable corridor (below MHWS). As you may be aware, the Project DCO boundary extends to MLWS, therefore there is a crossover between the remit of NRW and Denbighshire County Council.</p> <p>The Marine Licence (RML2323v1) covering the offshore site investigation campaign includes the intertidal boreholes, however, the offshore methodology comprising of a jack-up barge to collect boreholes would be inappropriate in the intertidal area. Therefore, we propose to collect the boreholes in the intertidal area by accessing them from onshore and using light cable percussion drilling methodologies as part of the onshore ground investigation works. Please see the foreshore Construction Phase Plan attached for further information (PN234604 AYM Foreshore work CPP Rev02). The scope of the works can be found within Section 1a, and Section 3 part XV describes traffic routes (including access to site(s)), and segregation of vehicles and pedestrians.</p> <p>Within the DCO Article 15: "Authority to survey and investigate the land" gives permission for the project to undertake investigation surveys within the AyM project boundary as long as notice is served.</p> <p>The onshore contractor is also required to comply with the outline management plans as submitted during the Examination (including a pollution prevention and emergency incident response plan) and they will also submit their own method statements and risk assessments for approval by AyM.</p> <p>Please also find attached the onshore WSI (231905_AwelYMor_Onshore_GI_WB) which includes details of the watching brief methodologies. This has been approved by CPAT and illustrates the locations of the two boreholes that will be monitored by Wessex Archaeology in Figures 1 and 2. The intertidal borehole locations and onshore WSI has also been sent to the RCAHMW.</p>
