**ENFORCEMENT NOTICE TO TAKE SPECIFIED STEPS IN RELATION TO A
BREACH/ANTICIPATED BREACH OF PERMIT CONDITION(S)**

Environmental permit: EPR/RP3098FM

Regulated facility: Ammanford Recycling Limited. The Old Wagon Works, Shands Road, Ammanford. SA18 3QU.

Natural Resources Wales considers that the following conditions of the environmental permit are being contravened:

Condition 5.1.4 Leaks and spillages (E2 Land and Groundwater). "In the event of any potentially polluting leak or spillage occurring on site, documented control and remediation procedures shall be implemented immediately and recorded, and shall meet the standards specified in Table 5.1."

Because:

On the 01 March 2024, a potentially polluting leak or spillage occurring on site had not been cleaned up or actioned as specified in Table 5.1. of the permit.

Condition 2.1.1 and table 2.1 (Containment of stored Materials). This condition states that ELV waste must be stored on an impermeable pavement with a sealed drainage system.

Because:

On the 01 March 2024, it was observed that oily waste and engines stored in designated 'oily waste area' had been pushed to the rear of the pad and were lying against the earth bund, the earth here was visually contaminated with oil and poses a significant risk to the surrounding environment.

Condition 2.1.1 and Table 2.1 (Materials acceptance). This condition details permitted waste types.

Because:

On the 01 March 2024, it was observed that unpermitted waste types mainly non ELV waste e.g. scrap metal was being stored and treated on site.

You are required to take the steps set out in Schedule 1 by the dates specified in order to remedy the contravention.

Notes:

General

1. Failure to comply with this notice is an offence under Regulation 38(3) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 and may result in legal action being taken against you.
2. Without prejudice to the requirements of this notice, failure to comply with a condition of an environmental permit is an offence and may result in legal action being taken against you.
3. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

Appeal provisions

You are entitled to appeal against this Notice under Regulation 31(1)(f) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016. Notice of appeal must be made within two months of the date of this notice. An appeal does not affect the requirements of this notice.

At the same time you must send a copy of the appeal notice and documents to Natural Resources Wales.

The required documents are:

- A statement of the grounds of appeal
- A copy of any relevant application
- A copy of any relevant environmental permit
- A copy of any relevant correspondence between the appellant and the regulator
- A copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal
- A statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.

You may withdraw an appeal by notifying PEDW in writing and sending a copy of that notification to Natural Resources Wales. Further information about making an appeal and the forms that you will need are available from PEDW.

Legislation note

In this document "Natural Resources Wales" means the Natural Resources Body for Wales established by Article 3 of the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Establishment) Order 2012. On 01 April 2013 the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Functions) Order 2013 transferred the relevant functions of the Countryside Council for Wales, and functions of the Environment Agency and the Forestry Commission in Wales to the Natural Resources Body for Wales.
