# Statutory Notice

**Environmental Protection Act 1990, Section 34(5) and the Waste (England and Wales) Regulations 2011, Regulation 35**

## REQUIREMENT TO FURNISH WRITTEN DESCRIPTIONS AND/OR TRANSFER NOTES

As the transferor or transferee of waste, you are required to keep a written description of that waste ("the transfer note") or a copy of that note, for a period of two years from the date of the transfer.

Using powers provided by Section 34(5) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and Regulation 35 of the Waste (England and Wales) Regulations 2011, **Natural Resources Wales** requires you to produce a copy of the documents specified below to us within **14 days** of the service of this notice.

### Specified documents:

Duty of Care 'Waste Transfer Notes' relating to the waste received at Withyhedge MRF Transfer Station permitted site EPR/QP3098FL from **01 October 2023 to 31 March 2024 inclusive**. This relates to incoming wastes for Q4 2023 and Q1 2024.

## **Environmental Protection Act 1990, Section 34(5) and the Waste (England and Wales) Regulations 2011, Regulation 35**

### **Notes:**

#### **General**

1. A “transferor” is a person who passes on controlled waste and a “transferee” is a person who receives that controlled waste.
2. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

#### **Appeal provisions**

There is no provision for appeal available in the legislation against this requirement.

#### **Penalties**

Failure to comply with this requirement is an offence and may result in legal action being taken against you.

#### **Legislation note**

In this document “Natural Resources Wales” means the Natural Resources Body for Wales established by Article 3 of the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Establishment) Order 2012. On 01 April 2013 the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Functions) Order 2013 transferred the relevant functions of the Countryside Council for Wales, and functions of the Environment Agency and the Forestry Commission in Wales to the Natural Resources Body for Wales.
