As agreed in the previous discharge of these condtions, the licence holder will carry out the met mast removal in two parts.

First schedule of works to take place between 01 July - 31 July 2024 for partial removal of the lattice mast only. Vessel WIND SERVER will carry out the partial removal. Biosecurity Risk Assessment has been amended to reflect new dates, new vessel and different ports to the previously submitted Risk Assessment where the conditions were discharged on the 17 July 2023. The licence holder is aware of the 6 week review period and would like to please request if a slightly shorter review time and condition discharge could be agreed to allow the work to go ahead from the 01 July 2024.
