**You asked to revoke (give up) water abstraction licences
Licence numbers: 21/57/12/0028 & 21/57/12/0100**

Thank you for your application to revoke the above licences. I can confirm that we have carried this out and this applies from 09/04/2019.

Please be reminded that you are no longer legally allowed to abstract water from the place and for the purposes stated in the licence. If you want to abstract water again you may need to apply for a new licence. Any new application will normally have to be advertised and there is no guarantee that the application will be successful.

You will need to tell us how much water you abstracted until the licence was revoked. Forms will be sent to you in due course, please complete and return to NRW to the address specified on the form.

For health and safety reasons, and to avoid groundwater becoming contaminated, if you are not going to use the well or borehole, we advise you put it out of use by following the steps in the enclosed leaflet.

Your licence was revoked from the date we received your request, but you are still liable for the charges until that date. We will send you a revised account when we receive your final return.
