Thanks for your email about the work at Penmaenmawr. We have no objections from a marine archaeological perspective as there are no records of any maritime archaeological material on the beach at the works location in either the National Monuments Record, or the regional historic environment record.

The only caveat is that things are frequently exposed on beaches as sediment levels change, so if anything is observed that appears to be archaeological, then we would appreciate being notified so that we can add it to the various records.

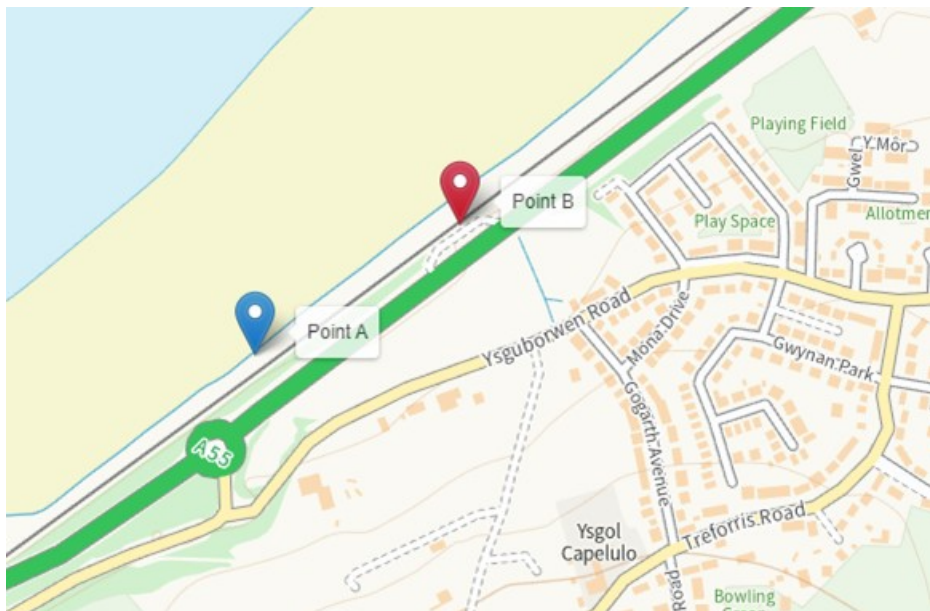
Please could you have a look at the planned works below at Penmaenmawr gas works sea defence and let me know of any concerns you may have?
