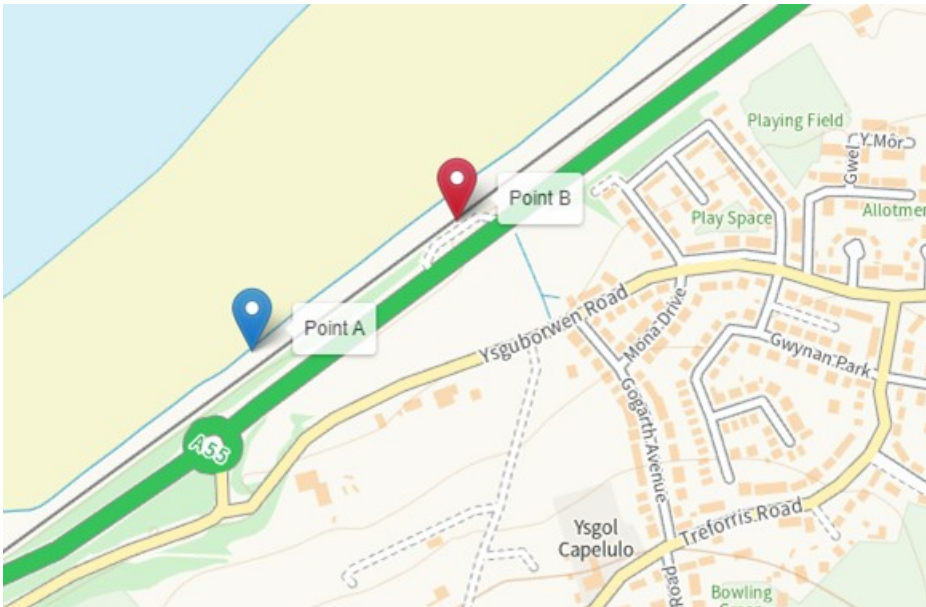
Please could you have a look at the planned works below at Penmaenmawr gas works sea defence and let me know of any concerns you may have?
