Abstraction Licence WA/060/0001/0022/V002, Ystradffin.

During our site meeting on the 18th April 2024 you requested clarification from Natural Resources Wales (NRW) on the interpretation of the wording “calendar days” and “consecutive days” within your abstraction licence conditions below:

- Calendar days in Condition 9.6 (ii) and Condition 9.6 (iii)
- Consecutive days in Condition 9.8 (ii)

We have reviewed the determination report and liaised with our permitting team along with our fisheries colleagues. We confirm that the definition of a day is 24 consecutive hours and note this as such on the file.

This means that for future reference, the period of days referred to in the relevant conditions starts when a specified threshold is reached, e.g. 9am, and ends 10 days later, i.e. 10*24 hours, or 240 hours later. For example, in 9.6(ii), if completion of stage 3B is 9am on the 10th June, 10 days later will be 9am on 20th June.
