

Waste Rejection

Introduction To ensure that all appropriate checks are undertaken, and records completed before waste is dispatched from Egan Waste Services site and direct from tankers. This procedure applies to all sites and tankers, when waste dispatched directly from customers.

Procedure

Rejection of Bulk Waste

- Bulk Waste that arrives at Egan Waste Services may fail the acceptance procedure because of non-compliance with the pre-acceptance details, consignment note details or unsuitable to be processed at the Egan Waste Services Site and therefore may be rejected from site.
- Waste must be rejected in accordance with the Hazardous Waste Regulations.
- For all rejected loads, a non-conformance must be completed.

Rejection of Containerised Waste

- Containerised waste that arrives at the Egan Waste Services Site may fail the acceptance procedure because of non-compliance with the pre-acceptance details, consignment note details or visual check and therefore may be rejected from site.
- Waste must be rejected in accordance with the Hazardous Waste Regulations.
- For all rejected loads, a non-conformance must be completed.

Rejection of Skip Waste

- A check of the load shall be made by Site Office / Weighbridge staff with reference to the waste acceptance procedure which shall include any analysis of material if applicable.
- If the load is different to the analysis provided or description the Site Office shall contact the customer to validate the changes.
- If the delivery is acceptable under the Permit Condition, then the written description and EWC code shall be changed on the paperwork to reflect the correct description.
- Any non-conforming materials shall be handled in accordance with the relevant procedure and quarantined.

For all rejected loads, a non-conformance must be completed.

Important

For all waste rejections a non-conformance form SHEQ-FOR-QAS-009 must be completed to ensure that the issue does not occur again.

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
