300mm d Stormwater outfall from Old college through promenade wall to Flap valve fixed to wall, at a level of 7.00 AOD.

Excavate road side of Promenade wall.
450mm d Core through Promenade wall from road side excavation.
Fix flap valve to wall
Reinstate promenade paving

Coreing of wall from road side prevents spill of wet drilling slurry into marine environment, slurry will be retained in and removed from road side excavation.
Minor Grouting / concrete to fix flap valve into promenade wall, beach side of sea wall will be sealed & formwork placed to prevent spills beach side, grout / concrete will be poured from road side of wall - surplus concrete will be removed to site skips, any washing out will be on site into dedicated skips, within the compound of Old College.

Pedestrians on promenade walkway will be locally diverted around works, promenade route will remain useable, works area will be fenced.
Cones, hazard tape and a Marshall will be used to manage public & segregate at rocky area / beach level whilst coring and installation of flap valve. Works will be undertaken when tide is receding / low tide. Segregation at beach level will be removed when tide is incoming

Works do not affect navigation within water.
Promenade will be securely fenced and highlighted with signage. Promenade walkway is lit overnight.
Promenade will remain usable to public.
