Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to inform you that Natural Resources Wales is withdrawing the Suspension Notices for the Environmental permits (ref EPR/FP3095ET & EPR/KP3790VF) that are held by South Wales Wood Recycling Limited at Locks Yard and The Recycling Building, Heol Llan, Bridgend.

As you are aware, on the 18th July, and subsequently 13th September, Natural Resources Wales issued you with Suspension Notices, suspending operations at the above named permitted facilities. These permits were suspended due to contravention of permit conditions and the resulting risk of pollution. Following recent email submissions illustrating your progress to reduce waste storage, a site visit was undertaken by NRW on 20th September. This visit confirmed that the quantity of waste stored on site had reduced. The stack size and height had been reduced, the area available as quarantine has increased and fire breaks between stacks were being formed. A Compliance Assessment Report (CAR) form detailing the above visit will be forwarded in due course.

Following liaison with our legal team NRW is satisfied that the Suspension Notices can be withdrawn as the previous risks that had been present, that led to the partial suspension of permitted activities, are now reduced.

Please note that a lapse in waste storage or throughput management that result in breaches of permit conditions at the sites may lead to NRW serving further suspension notices and other enforcement action.
