Accordingly, please find attached for your review and retention a copy of Marine Licence CML2270v1 and its conditions. Please note that Marine Licence CML2270v1 supersedes Marine Licence CML2270 in its entirety.

The design for the reconstructed dolphin mooring has changed from one 2.1m diameter pile to five individual 0.6m piles.

The licence expiry date is also extending from 31 December 2024 to 31 December 2025.
