Having considered the likely impact of the operation(s) described in your notice dated 19/12/2023 on the special features of the site(s) listed above; insofar as it is required in the exercise of your functions as a Section 28G Authority:

Natural Resources Wales hereby assents that,

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May carry out the operation(s) specified below in the manner prescribed:

Works on the island to the north west of the Anglesey inland sea located at SH 27505 80021, to improve the suitability and extent of habitat for nesting terns, as well as reduce predation.

This assent is subject to the following conditions:

Condition	Condition Reason
Works to take place outside of bird breeding season.	To minimize impact on bird features of the site.
All equipment to be clean and dry before and after entering the site.	To minimize the risk of spreading non-native invasive species and diseases.

This assent is valid until: 01/10/2027
To allow enough time for the works to be completed.
