What is the project title?

Westfield Pill Bridge refurbishment

Briefly describe what you want to do

Bridge repair and refurbishment work is to be undertaken on the Westfield Pill Bridge, near Neyland on the A477, which carries the highway over the Cleddau Ddu waterway at a height of over 30m above the river and wooded river banks. The Cleddau Ddu runs into the Milford Haven waterway. Main items are replacement of the bridge parapets and expansion joints and resurfacing of the carriageway.

When do you want the licence to start?

Band 1 licences are typically issued for one year, subject to consultation.
