Overleaf is an explanation of the reasons and details of certain EWC codes and mixed waste EWC codes applied for.

EWC Codes Explanation

The site is a plastic recycling facility, however due to the household and household like packaging received at site and the industrial/commercial collections undertaken, it is inevitable that other non-core recyclables will be delivered to site. The EWC Code list has been reviewed to account for all eventualities.

EWC Code	Reason for inclusion in permit application
15 01 01 paper and cardboard packaging and 20 01 01 paper and cardboard	Some customers may put a bale of cardboard on the same collection as their plastic collection. This code is to ensure that cardboard is correctly coded when received into site.
15 01 05 composite packaging	Plastic composite packaging may be received on site
15 01 06 mixed packaging	Mixed packaging loads may be received i.e mixed bottles and metal drinks cans. This material will be mechanically and optically sorted before the plastic is reprocessed.
19 12 04 plastic and rubber	Plastic may be purchased from a Material Recycling Facilities who have separated the plastic. The plastic material will therefore be received from a 19 chapter waste facility.
19 12 12 other wastes (dry mixed recyclables only)	Mixed bottles and cans may be received from a waste facility that have treated the wastes to generate the mixed bottle and cans load. The mixed material will therefore be received from a 19 chapter waste facility.
20 03 01 mixed municipal waste (dry mixed recyclables only)	Mixed bottles and cans can be received from industrial and commercial processes and therefore received from a chapter 20 producer.
