The new monitoring programme proposes to set calendar year windows to complete the monitoring surveys (iRGMP, RGMP and RSMP) with the associated reporting due to be submitted to NRW within the calendar year following the calendar year of the surveys. At present the monitoring reporting deadline is nine months after the survey, which is proving to be not achievable.

In addition, the substantive review will be aligned with the monitoring programme to ensure there is time to include the most up to date monitoring data. This means the substantive review will be due within the calendar year following the calendar year that the monitoring reports are due. This approach is consistent with MMO for the English side of Area 531 as well as all other marine licences in English waters around the UK.

These changes will allow the Area 531 and Area 526 monitoring programmes to be aligned making joint "survey years" and "monitoring reporting years". This will give a wider survey window as opposed to the current and more restrictive autumn/winter shared survey window.
