<p>Varying the Area 531 marine licence condition 3.5.8 to make the monitoring reporting deadline match the new monitoring plan submitted on 28/11/2024 via the NRW's "apply to discharge a marine licence condition" portal. The new deadline is proposed to be the end of the calendar year that follows the calendar year of the associated monitoring surveys. This is currently in place with the MMO for all licence areas in English waters, including 531. At present the monitoring reporting deadline is nine months after the survey, which is proving to be not achievable.</p> <p>Also to vary marine licence condition 3.6.2 so that the Substantive Review deadline will be the end of the calendar year following the calendar year in which the monitoring reporting is due, as we have in place already with the MMO. This will allow enough time to include the most up to date monitoring data in the substantive review.</p> <p>The attached Gantt chart details the current and proposed monitoring schedule timings.</p>
