Briefly describe what you want to do

To carry out a single bore hole for a feasibility survey to investigate the geology of the Northern area of Newgale beach Pembrokeshire ahead of the proposed subsea cable landing which requires horizontal directional drilling.
In order to gain access to the beach we will be using a flat bottomed landing vessel to take the drill rig to the drill location and beach the vessel on the out going tide.
