What is the project title?

Traeth Crugan Beach Recycling

Briefly describe what you want to do

Traeth Crugan erodes over time, and the material is carried long-shore by coastal processes and accretes at the harbour entrance. The accretion of sands and gravels at the harbour entrance poses a problem to harbour users and is therefore dredged, under the powers provided to Cyngor Gwynedd under the Local Harbour Act. The material is stored for use for recycling at Traeth Crugan and has been identified as the most cost-effective option for protecting the coast in the short-terms.

When do you want the licence to start?

Band 1 licences are typically issued for one year, subject to consultation.

A 360 tracked excavator will be positioned at the stockpile at Garreg yr Imbyll to load 40-ton dump trucks with previously stockpiled sand and gravel from the mouth of Pwllheli Harbour. This sand will then be transported through the Gimblet Rock Holiday Park and on to the beach immediately adjacent. The dump trucks will be restricted to designated lanes on the upper 20m of the beach.
