## Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 Regulation 36

### ENFORCEMENT NOTICE TO TAKE SPECIFIED STEPS IN RELATION TO A BREACH/ANTICIPATED BREACH OF PERMIT CONDITION

**Natural Resources Wales** considers that the following condition of the environmental permit has been contravened:

**Condition 1.1.1** – *No waste management operations shall be authorised by this license unless a) specified in and undertaken in accordance with the limitations in table 1.1 of the permit.*

Because total wastes stored exceed the maximum storage capacity of 90 tonnes as specified in Table 1.1 Specified waste management operations.

You are required to take the steps set out in Schedule 1 by the date specified in order to remedy the contravention.

##### General

1. Failure to comply with this notice is an offence under Regulation 38(3) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 and may result in legal action being taken against you.
2. Without prejudice to the requirements of this notice, failure to comply with a condition of an environmental permit is an offence and may result in legal action being taken against you.
3. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

##### Appeal provisions

You are entitled to appeal against this notice under Regulation 31(1)(f) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016. Notice of appeal must be made within two months of the date of this notice. An appeal does not affect the requirements of this notice.

At the same time you must send a copy of the appeal notice and documents to Natural Resources Wales.

The required documents are:

- A statement of the grounds of appeal
- A copy of any relevant application
- A copy of any relevant environmental permit
- A copy of any relevant correspondence between the appellant and the regulator
- A copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal
- A statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.

You may withdraw an appeal by notifying Planning and Environment Decisions Wales in writing and sending a copy of that notification to Natural Resources Wales. Further information about making an appeal and the forms that you will need are available from Planning and Environment Decisions Wales detailed above.

##### Legislation note

In this document "Natural Resources Wales" means the Natural Resources Body for Wales established by Article 3 of the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Establishment) Order 2012. On 01 April 2013 the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Functions) Order 2013 transferred the relevant functions of the Countryside Council for Wales, and functions of the Environment Agency and the Forestry Commission in Wales to the Natural Resources Body for Wales.
