## **1. INTRODUCTION**

The Manure Management Plan presented has been prepared to accompany the permit variation application for the farming business Mr Martyn Langford to change House 1 from a 16,000 flat deck system to a 24,000 multi-tier system. The total birds on farm would change from 56,000 to 64,000.

## **2. PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT AND FARM STOCKING**

The proposed development is for an increase from 56,000 birds to 64,000 birds within the existing three poultry houses at Rhosddu Farm.

## **3. STORAGE OF MANURE - EXISTING**

All solid manure produced within the poultry units is currently removed every four days. All manure from the three poultry houses is spread on neighbouring land.

## **4. STORAGE OF MANURE - PROPOSED**

Once House 1 has changed to a multi-tier system, all manure will be exported to an AD plant.

House 1 – exported to an AD plant

House 2 – exported to an AD plant

House 3 – exported to an AD plant

## **5. MANURE STORAGE**

### **Existing Manure Store**

Manure in the worst case can be stored in the existing manure/slurry store.

Manure will be stored in accordance with SSAFO (Water Resources Act (Control of Pollution) (Silage Slurry and Agricultural Fuel Oil) (Wales) Regulations 2010).

## **6. “DIRTY” YARD AREAS**

### **“Dirty” Yards**

The “dirty” yard areas on the farm will be kept to a minimum. This is due to the manure all being contained in the poultry unit and removed every four days together with the hardcore area to the front of the poultry unit.

Rhosddu Farm has a dirty water tank installed on farm. The waste water tank will be built in compliance with the SSAFO standards.

## **7. CONTINGENCY PLAN**

In the event that manure cannot be exported off site immediately to an AD plant, it will be stored in the existing manure store on site before being exported.

All contaminated wash water will be stored in the dirty water tank upon farm.
