## Schedule

1. Risk assessment on sewer discharge:

**Provide a copy of the H1 assessment for relevant hazardous substances to sewer (as required by improvement condition 4 of the permit). If one has not been completed, provide confirmation that one has not been completed.**

Reason for the information:

As part of your application, you have requested amendments to the description of table S3.2 sewer discharge and monitoring requirements to reflect missing information identified during the BRef Review of the permit. The clarification was added to the permit to be addressed in the form of two improvement conditions (IC) summarised below;

- IC 3: Asking for evidence with compliance with BAT conclusions including BAT 20 (discharge to sewer).
- IC 4: - Phase 1 screening test report for priority hazardous pollutants and any other relevant priority hazardous substances discharged to sewer. For any substance which is not screened out by the screening tests, further modelling should be undertaken

IC4 was due 17/02/2022 but it had been stated that in the compliance assessment report dated 17/02/2023 (reference: CAR\_NRW0041225) that this had not been completed at the time.

As your variation application includes proposals to amend the sewer discharges listed in Table S3.2 we require more information on any updates on the status of improvement condition 4 in order to make a decision if any additional conditions or monitoring might be required for the sewer discharge on the permit.
