Good morning Simon,

I was dealing with this yesterday. I had a call with advisors to make sure I understand their concerns and the best way forward. Please find attached NRW Advisory's response to the consultation to discharge condition 3.18 and 3.20 of marine licence CML2147.

NRW Advisory has still concerns regarding the saltmarsh and have agreed with a partial discharge of the CEMP and SMP until saltmarsh surveys are completed. This will allow you to work in areas where there is no saltmarsh (outside the saltmarsh extent as described in [CML2147 - CCD JBAU XX 00 DR EN 0001 S3-P02.03-Saltmarsh Extents 02.05.2024](#)) until the necessary saltmarsh surveys are undertaken this spring/summer and development of further mitigation, based on the outcomes of those surveys is submitted. Following the surveys advisors will expect the CEMP to include specific measure such as the detail of trackways and demarcation of sensitive areas etc. The SMP should include following the saltmarsh surveys details of mitigation measures to safeguard these sensitive habitats and species during works, and to map out the habitat recovery phase once the scheme is operational, including the identification of when intervention required, and what that intervention should be. NRW Advisory refer you to their previous comments dated 26 March 2024 (also attached for clarity), including comments on the pre- and post-construction surveys and monitoring, as a number of these issues will need to be examined and addressed as part of the evolution of the Saltmarsh Management Plan document.

Therefore, on this occasion we will be able to partially discharge condition 3.18 and 3.20 of your licence to conduct the licenced activities only in the areas outside the identified as saltmarsh extent as per: [CML2147 - CCD JBAU XX 00 DR EN 0001 S3-P02.03-Saltmarsh Extents 02.05.2024](#)

We will expect a revised CEMP and SMP to be submitted for approval which will be incorporating the saltmarsh survey information and mitigation measures as stated above and in NRW Advisory's response.
