

Natural Resources Wales permitting decisions

Variation

We have decided to issue the variation for Machen Quarry operated by Hanson Quarry Products Europe Limited.

The variation number is EPR/KB3835RT/V003.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements and that the permit will ensure that the appropriate level of environmental protection is provided.
